How many points does a Bems have?

A small building may have a BEMS with 10 or less points. A large BEMS may have thousands of points. An organization may have BEMS on multiple sites around the country that are linked to a central location, which can then monitor thousands of points. Through the graphic or keypad displays, staff can input desired conditions and set operating times.

Can a BEMs tie into a BACnet-compatible BMS?

Ensuring that the BEMS can tie into a BACnet-compatible BMSis crucial for full functionality. It allows for the comprehensive collection and analysis of data from all endpoints. For a BEMS to deliver its full value, it needs access to high-quality data and coverage of every critical endpoint in the building.

What is the Pitcairn Islands Marine Protected Area Ordinance?

The Pitcairn Islands Marine Protected Area Ordinance (GPI,2017) established CCAs (Community Conservation Areas) that extend out to 12 nautical miles around each of the islands. These areas enclose what have traditionally been known as 'territorial waters'.

According to Sala et al. (2012),the global biological value of the marine ecosystem,both shallow and deep,of the Pitcairn Islands' Exclusive Economic Zone is outstanding and deserves strict protection as a no-take marine reserve.

What is the extent of the CCA around Pitcairn?

The CCA around Pitcairn extends 40 nm to the southeastin a tapering triangle shape and then encloses Adam's Seamount (known locally as 40 Mile Reef) with a 2 nm radius. The reason for designating the tapering triangular shape is to allow Pitcairners the opportunity to undertake trolling during the journey to/from 40 Mile Reef.
