What is battery energy storage system (BESS)?

Battery energy storage system (BESS) projects offer a critical solution to the intermittency issue, enhancing grid stability and bolstering the resilience and reliability of the electricity supply system. In August 2022, Prime Minister Fumio Kishida advocated for an acceleration of standalone BESS projects.

How much electricity can a Bess store?

Once live the BESS will be capable of storing enough electricity to power approximately 63,000 households for four hours¹. Project financing has been arranged by MUFG Bank representing the first battery storage project they have arranged finance for in Japan.

How much electricity does Hirohara Bess provide?

With a rated output of 30 MW and a storage capacity of 120 MWh, Hirohara BESS will be capable of providing four hours of electricity to approximately 63,000 households, about one-third of Miyazaki City's population. This project represents a significant step toward reducing carbon emissions and increasing energy security in the region.

When will a Bess battery be built?

Construction is scheduled to begin in the second half of 2024 and the battery is expected to begin operating in July 2026. Once live the BESS will be capable of storing enough electricity to power approximately 63,000 households for four hours.
