The United Nations Statistics Division also uses this code,but has named it the Svalbard and Jan Mayen Islands. Svalbard is an archipelago in the Arctic Oceanunder the sovereignty of Norway,but is subject to the special status granted by the Svalbard Treaty.

What do Svalbard and Jan Mayen have in common?

Svalbard and Jan Mayen have in common that they are the only integrated parts of Norway not allocated to counties. While a separate ISO code for Svalbard was proposed by the United Nations, it was the Norwegian authorities who took initiative to include Jan Mayen in the code. Its official language is Norwegian.

Who governs Svalbard?

The archipelago is administered by the Governor of Svalbard, which is subordinate to the Norwegian Ministry of Justice and Public Security. Unlike the rest of Norway (including Jan Mayen), Svalbard is a free economic zone and a demilitarized zone, and is not part of the Schengen Area nor the European Economic Area.

Nord-Jan has a round shape and is dominated by the 2,277 m (7,470 ft) high Beerenberg volcano with its large ice cap (114.2 km 2 or 44 sq mi), which can be divided into twenty individual outlet glaciers. The largest of those is Sørbreen, with an area of 15 km 2 (5.8 sq mi) and a length of 8.7 km (5.41 mi).

Described as one of the most remote islands in the world, Jan Mayen lies between Norway to the east and Greenland to the west. It is a rugged volcanic island 34 miles long and is made up of two parts - the larger section to the north (Beerenbeg Volcano) and the longer but narrower section to the south. A mile-wide isthmus links these two parts.
