

Where are the Heard and McDonald Islands located?

The Heard and McDonald Islands are remote subantarctic volcanic features located in the Southern Ocean,halfway between Australia and South Africa. They are approximately 1700 km from the Antarctic continent and 4000 km southwest of mainland Australia (Australian Government 2016). Heard Island is 43 km long and 21 km wide.

How big is Heard Island & McDonald Islands?

The group's overall land area is 372 km 2 (144 sq mi)and it has 101.9 km (63 mi) of coastline. Discovered in the mid-19th century,the islands lie on the Kerguelen Plateau in the Indian Ocean and have been an Australian territory since 1947. Heard Island and McDonald Islands contain Australia's only two active volcanoes.

Why is Heard Island a low flora?

Heard Island supports a relatively low number of terrestrial invertebrate species compared to other Southern Ocean islands,in parallel with the low species richness in the flora-that is,the island's isolation and limited ice-free area.

The December solstice (summer solstice) in Territory of Heard Island and McDonald Islands is at 2:20 pm on Saturday, December 21, 2024. In terms of daylight, this day is 9 hours, 25 minutes longer than the June solstice. In locations south of the equator, the longest day of the year is around this date.
