

Installing photovoltaic panels near high-voltage lines

Where is a photovoltaic array installed?

Photovoltaic arrays are typically installed on rooftops, near power transmission lines, constructed of aluminum frames, and must be free from objects that shade them. Optimum exposure to sunlight also means increased vulnerability during electrical storms.

Could a transmission right-of-way corridor protect high-voltage power lines?

It could. Transmission right-of-way corridors, vast swaths of vegetation-free landscape to protect high-voltage power lines, could provide enough space for over 600,000 megawatts of solar photovoltaics (PV). These arrays could provide enough electricity to meet 20 percent of the country's electric needs.

What are the requirements for solar panel installation?

Enforce enforcement action by HSE inspectors. Solar panel installation is not short duration work and will need scaffolding or similar equipment. It should have a boarded working platform and full edge protection (double guard-rails and toe-boards) to stop people and tools from falling. Debris netting may also be necessary to prevent materials

Why should PV be integrated in a power system?

Generally, the integration of PV in a power system increases its reliability as the burden on the synchronous generator as well as on the transportation lines is mitigated [1,2].

How much voltage does a solar farm need?

If the nearest transmission line to your property has a voltage of, say, 115 kV (115,000 volts), the output voltage from the solar farm needs to "step up" to 115 kV to feed power into it. Likewise, the power that line carries to a neighborhood 50 miles away eventually needs to "step down" in voltage so that homes can use it.

What equipment do I need to install a solar heating system?

Cordless portable equipment is preferred. If you are using 230/240 V power tools and equipment, ensure they are undamaged and a current device (RCD) is used.
