### What are the components of microgrid control?

The microgrid control consists of: (a) micro source and load controllers, (b) microgrid system central controller, and (c) distribution management system. The function of microgrid control is of three sections: (a) the upstream network interface, (b) microgrid control, and (c) protection, local control.

### What is the nature of microgrid?
