What is the history of South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The history of South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is relatively recent. When European explorers discovered the islands, they were uninhabited, and their hostile climate, mountainous terrain, and remoteness made subsequent settlement difficult.

Is South Georgia a small island?

It is a remote and inhospitable collection of islands, consisting of South Georgia and a chain of smaller islands known as the South Sandwich Islands. South Georgia is 165 kilometres (103 mi) long and 35 kilometres (22 mi) wide and is by far the largest island in the territory.

Are South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands mountainous?

South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands are a collection of islands in the South Atlantic Ocean. Most of the islands, rising steeply from the sea, are rugged and mountainous. At higher elevations, the islands are permanently covered with ice and snow.

What is the ccTLD for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The Internet country code top-level domain (ccTLD) for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is .gs. The parts of the islands that are not permanently covered in snow or ice are part of the Scotia Sea Islands tundra ecoregion.

Who owns South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The United Kingdom claimed sovereignty over South Georgia in 1775 and the South Sandwich Islands in 1908. The territory of "South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands" was formed in 1985; previously, it had been governed as part of the Falkland Islands Dependencies.

What is happening in South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands?

There are also a series of no-take zones around the islands, and the closure of the krill fishery November to March, when krill-eating birds and marine mammals are breeding. In 2018 the Government of South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands (GSGSSI) announced further protections:

About the Islands. South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is a remote inhospitable overseas territory of the British Government. The largest amongst smaller Islands that make up South Sandwich Islands. It is regarded as a sovereign state and separate from the Falkland Islands.

Winter, from June to August, brings extreme conditions to the South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands. With average temperatures oscillating between -2°C (28.4°F) and 2°C (35.6°F), the islands experience intense cold, frequent snowstorms, and strong winds, with speeds reaching up to 40km/h (24.9mph).

Argentina has claimed the South Sandwich Islands and South Georgia as its territory since the late 1920s. Since Argentina's ill-fated attempt to take the closer Falkland Islands from the United Kingdom in 1982, the South Sandwich Islands have been mainly home of a small population of fisherman and scientists with their families.

United Kingdom is approximately 243,610 sq km, while South Georgia and South Sandwich Islands is approximately 3,903 sq km, making South Georgia and South Sandwich Islands 1.6% the size of United Kingdom.
