What happens if a solar panel is not connected?

When a solar panel is not connected, but still it is exposed to solar radiation, it will continue to produce electricity. This extra electricity can lead to overheating and cause the voltage across the panel to be converted into heat. This can potentially lead to a fire hazard if solar panels are not regularly checked and maintained.

Why are my solar panels not working?

Obstructions like trees and buildings throw shade on your solar panels, blocking the sun and preventing them from producing energy. If your solar panels are not producing as much power as they once did, check for new obstructions that didn't exist when you installed your system.
