This angle is typically between 30 degrees and 45 degrees. Doing so ensures your home will get the maximum average output from your solar power system throughout the year. The time of year can certainly depict how effectively your solar panels work due to the sun's position.

What angle should a photovoltaic panel face?

In the northern hemisphere, the sun is due south at solar noon. Therefore, to get the very best out of your photovoltaic panels, you would typically face them due south at the optimum angle so that the panel is receiving as much sunlight as possible at this time.
